TAAFC DISCIPLINARY POLICY

TAAFC expects all members, referees, administrators, associates, coaches, players, volunteers and parents and guardians to abide by the Code of Conduct as set out in the applicable document.

Any alleged breaches of the Code of Conduct should be brought to the attention of a committee member as soon as is practicable.

This policy sets out the procedure should a breach of the Code of Conduct be brought to the attention of the Committee.

When a committee member is advised of an alleged breach of the Code of Conduct, they will immediately notify the club secretary who will convene a sub committee to investigate the alleged breach.

The sub committee shall consist of the secretary and two other nominated committee members. The sub committee shall, within 48 hours meet with the subject person of the alleged breach. The sub committee is authorised by the full committee to speak to any other persons so as to fully investigate the alleged breach.

Once the sub committee has completed their investigation, they will report back to the full committee with the information gathered and their recommendation. The committee will meet within 5 days to discuss the information gathered and make a decision as to what, if any action will be taken.

The outcome of the investigation and/or any consequences shall be notified to the subject person of the alleged breach as soon as is practicable after the full committee has met.
